Ensuring Safety On Board: ►

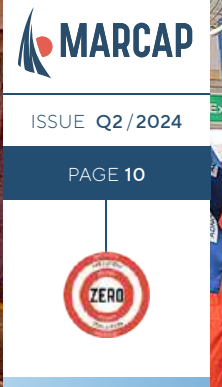
Management visits are pivotal in verifying that safety protocols are adhered to, reinforcing our safety-first culture.

• ► **Number 2 — Complacent Mindset** ▼

Routine tasks and activities can dull our defense mechanisms, causing our minds to stop noticing signs of danger. Remember that past outcomes do not guarantee future safety. Let us remain vigilant. **EXPECT THE UNEXPECTED** and avoid falling into the trap of routine!



• ► **Number 3 — Situational Awareness** ▼

Experience has shown that many incidents occur due to a lack of situational awareness. Common reasons behind such incidents include being unaware of our surroundings. Situational awareness is key to keeping everyone safe.

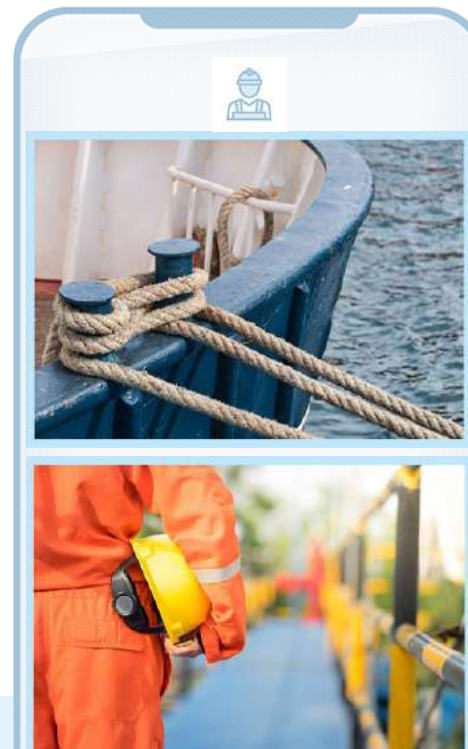
